TRAINING YOUTH TO BE LEADERS

Be a Counselor-In-Training (CIT) at Camp Mummichog!

You are eligible if you are between the ages of 12 and 19 and have attended two or more Coastal Rivers education programs, including at least one session of Camp Mummichog. Tuition is reduced by \$100 per session. CIT positions are limited to one session per individual.
